

Motive Waves

Motive waves possess a 5 wave structure that propels the market trend

Waves 1,3,5, A & C are motive.

Waves are motive when trending in the direction as the wave of 1 larger degree.

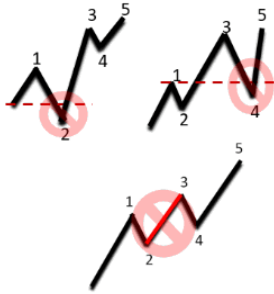


Rules of the Motive Wave

1. Wave 2 cannot retrace more than 100% of wave 1
2. Wave 4 cannot retrace more than 100% of wave 3
3. Wave 3 is often the longest, but is never the shortest trend wave

Motive Impulse Pattern

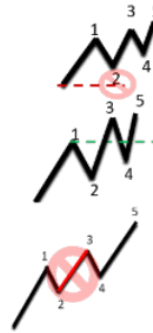
W.4 never overlaps W.1. Occurs in waves 1,3, and 5, and always wave 3. Also occurs in waves A and C.



1. Wave 2 can NOT retrace to the beginning (or beyond) of Wave 1.
2. Wave 4 can NOT touch Wave 2.
3. Wave 3 is often the longest, but it is never the shortest.

Motive Diagonal Pattern

W.4 usually overlaps W.1. Occurs in waves 1, and 5, never wave 3. Also occurs in waves A and C



1. Wave 2 can NOT retrace to the beginning (or beyond) of Wave 1.
2. Wave 4 MUST touch Wave 2.
3. Wave 1 often the longest, and wave often 5 the shortest, but wave 3 never the shortest
